Public Competition reserved for the admission, with scholarship, to the Master's Degree Course in Nutritional Sciences for the Academic Year 2020/21.

CONSIDERING that it is necessary to publish the announcement for admission to the master's degree courses for the academic year 2020-2021

ESTABLISHES THAT

Art.1 ANNOUNCEMENT

The University of Calabria announces the competition for admission, with a scholarship, to the Master's degree course in Nutritional Sciences, curriculum in "Nutritional Sciences", for the academic year 2020/21, reserved for countries subscribing to the UNESCO dossier "Mediterranean diet".

Art.2 Scholarships

The scholarships, financed with funds from the "University Departments of Excellence" project law 232/2016, will be reserved for foreign students from countries that have signed the dossier on the "Mediterranean Diet": Cyprus, Croatia, Greece, Morocco, Portugal, Spain. Each scholarship awarded will cover the costs of food, accommodation on the university campus and matriculation fees.

Art.3 Participation requirements

Candidates must have the following qualifications:

Master's Degree in: Pharmacy, Pharmaceutical Chemistry and Technology, Medicine and Surgery, Veterinary Medicine and / or equivalent.

Degree in: Nutritional Science, Pharmaceutical Sciences and Technologies, Biotechnologies, Biological Sciences, Agricultural and Food Sciences and Technologies, Chemical Sciences and Technologies and / or equivalent.

Language skills in English: B2 and / or higher levels.

Non-EU candidates, who require an entry visa to Italy for long-term stays, must register on the UNIVERSITALY portal (<https://www.university.it/index.php/registration/firststep>), in order to fill in online the pre-enrollment application required for issuing the entry visa for STUDY "University enrollment" / STUDIO "Immatricolazione Università".

For qualifications obtained abroad it is mandatory:

after enrollment, to submit to the Special International Relations Office, Welcome Office service, Via Savinio - Residential Centre area, within the first exam session of the academic year 2020/2021, the following documents: the educational qualification accompanied by an official/legal translation into Italian, authenticated by Italian Embassy or Consulate or Diplomatic office, competent for the territory or equipped with an Apostille and the Declaration of Value, issued by the Italian diplomatic office, competent for the territory or, alternatively, certification issued by ENIC Centres -NARIC (www.enic-naric.net/) in Italian or English, such as the Certificate of Comparability of the foreign qualification issued by CIMEA. (Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence)

Failure to deliver the indicated documentation within the established deadlines will result in the blocking of career documents on Esse3 (booking exams, requesting registration certificates, etc.). The documents in the career will be made operational upon delivery of all the required documentation.

Art.4 Application for participation

Candidates who aspire to benefit from the scholarships assigned to the English curriculum "Nutritional Sciences" of the Master's Degree Course in Nutritional Science for the academic year 2020/2021 must complete the online application by accessing the site:

The following must be attached to the application:

- 1) Front-back scanning of passport or other identity document;
- 2) Curriculum vitae (attachment 1) which includes all academic work experience in the field of the Master's Degree Course in Nutritional Science;
- 3) Official copy of the transcript of each post-secondary educational institution attended containing the list of courses and relative grade, the title of the degree achieved and the final grade;
- 4) The B2 level of English language proficiency certification issued by accredited international institutions, such as the Cambridge First Certificate (FCE), TOEFL, IELTS, (the minimum score to be considered equivalent to level B2 is the following: IELTS 5.5; TOEFL PBT 507-557; TOEFL CBT 180-2017; TOEFL IBT 80-99; Trinity College of London ISE II)

Art.5 Candidates with disabilities and candidates diagnosed with SLD

Candidates with disabilities, in accordance with Law no. 104/92 as amended by Law no. 17/99, in relation to their needs, can make an explicit request for support to the Student Service with disabilities, SLD (Specific learning disorders) and SEND (Special Educational Needs) and request the measures provided for by law.

Candidates diagnosed with Specific Learning Disorders (SLD), certified in accordance with Law n° 170/2010, may request any measures provided for by the same law (L.170 / 2010), from the Student Service with disabilities, SLD and SEND.

In order to obtain the facilities provided for students with disabilities and for students with SLD, the condition of disability or SLD must be declared when completing the online application and attached to it in the manner prescribed by the procedure.

In order to take advantage of the benefits provided, enrolled students must deliver the documents to the offices of the Student Service with Disabilities, SLD and SEND, located at the Residential Centre, within ten days after enrollment. Given the restrictions related to the Covid-19 emergency, the documentation can be sent to the University Student with Disabilities and SLD Service, via the email addresses indicated below.

Criteria for selection: the departmental commission appointed for this purpose will award the scholarships on the basis of academic merit and further academic qualifications achieved.

The grants of the 12 students who are beneficiaries of the scholarships shall be borne entirely by the funds of the project "University Departments of Excellence" Law 232/2016.

Art.9 Verifications

The declarations will be controlled. In the case of an ascertained untruthful declaration, the exclusion from the competition is proceeded with consequent forfeiture of the opportunity to enroll for the academic year 2020/2021. The administration reserves the right to carry out, even in the months following enrollment, further controls; any untruthful declarations will result in forfeiture of the career.

ADDENDUM A

Information pursuant to art. 13 Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (RGPD)

This information represents a fulfillment required by Regulation (EU) 2016/679, General Data Protection Regulation (hereinafter, RGPD), which, pursuant to art. 13, provides for the obligation to provide the interested parties with the information necessary to ensure correct and transparent processing of their personal data. This information is addressed to those who carry out their work at the University of Calabria.

Purpose and legal basis of the processing

The data subject to processing, provided at the time of the application for participation in the competition for admission to degree courses or, after passing this last phase, at the time of enrollment and during the training course up to the degree's final test, are collected and used within the limits established by law and regulations or processed for institutional purposes. It should be noted that the processing is carried out in compliance with the general principles of lawfulness, transparency, correctness, accuracy, minimization, confidentiality and integrity pursuant to art. 5 GDPR and that the data will be processed exclusively for the performance of administrative and educational activities. The University may also process personal data for statistical and scientific purposes, including that to facilitate the analysis and improvement of the activities and services of teaching, research and the right to study.

Methods of processing and interested parties

The personal data requested and acquired are collected and processed both in paper form and with electronic (computer) tools for purposes related to the performance of the University's institutional activities.

The determination of taxes and contributions involves the University access to the income data of the student's family unit. Such data are mainly processed by means of computer systems and are aimed at determining grants and university fees.

Data are also communicated to the Public Administrations in charge of the controls (for example, the Revenue Agency, Social Security and Finance Police).

Any eventual categories of particular data and / or judicial data will be processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation and in compliance with the Regulations for the processing of sensitive and judicial data of the University of Calabria.

The provision of some personal data (surname, name, residence, tax code, e-mail) is necessary for the establishment of the relationship between the student and the University, therefore it is to be considered mandatory. In case of failure to provide such data, it will not be possible for the University to activate and execute the related administrative procedure.

Rights of the Person concerned

The interested parties have the right to obtain from the Data Controller, in the cases provided for, access to personal data and the correction or cancellation of the same or the limitation of the processing that concerns them or to oppose the processing (articles 15 et seq. of the GDPR).

These rights may be exercised by writing to the Data Controller.
